The offer and structure of hotels in the mainland

The most developed is the National park Durmitor with the possibility of hiking in summertime and poor ski offer for winter. Its centre is the place called Zabljak, having the facilities including six B-category hotels, with the total of 843 beds. The walking tour area has the character of high mountains, while ski tracks, compared to Austrian, Swiss, Bavarian and Czech destinations may only be described as small, with little variety and unattractive.

Despite its naturally beautiful location, Zabljak (1640 m above sea level) is a resort with no attractions and charm - a sterile place. Zabljak can be no competition for the above-mentioned Central European destinations neither in hotel quality and apr s-ski scene nor as the area where guests may expect all kinds of winter sports.

In addition, the snow is certain only for 60 days a year. Having in mind great attractiveness of Central European competitors, their reputation and proximity, Durmitor/Zabljak have only marginal chances in international skiing competition. Nevertheless, they have to be enhanced as a regional attraction.

WORLD TRAVEL MARKET 2003

LONDON, 10-13 NOVEMBER 2003

One of the most interesting tourism events in the world, World Travel Market, was held in London from 10 –13 November at ExCel at the Docklands. At this year market, 24th in a row, Montenegro presented its tourism offer among 187 countries and over 17,100 exhibitors. According to experts, for all these years London Market has been both information and marketing forum, attracting and gathering representatives of tourism industry from all over the world.

The Montenegrin delegation was headed by Mr Predrag Nenezic, Minister of Tourism of Montenegro and Mr Vojin Vlahovic, acting director of National Tourism Organisation.

In order to provide for more complete and better information to the British public about the possibilities for staying in Montenegro a press conference was held at Reform Club on 10 November with the presentation of the BBC feature on Montenegro, broadcasted at BBC channel at the same time. There were 127 guests at the press cocktail, among them numerous journalists, representatives of "Bradt Travel Guides", the author of guide to Montenegro, Mrs Annalisa Rellie, investors, people from international financial institutions, diplomats and tour operators and travel agencies selling Montenegro for the summer 2004 at the market of the United Kingdom and Northern Ireland.

The British interested in spending their holidays in 2004 at the Montenegrin coast, may book with tour operators and travel agencies "Holiday Options", "Inghams", "Balkan Holidays", "Ultimate Travel", "Saga Travel" and "Concorde Travel"



from Ireland. Also, tour operators and travel agencies selling special programs for active holidays (among which First Choice should be pointed out), as well as those who used to sell Montenegro again showed interest in Montenegro.

What is certain for the time being is that during the summer 2004 from mid-June to mid-September there will be a direct flight London-Tivat, and there are certain indications that, depending on the interest shown from this market, JAT will have several flights a week from London airport Gatwick to Tivat.

Based on final talks, it is to be expected that some 4,000 tourists from United Kingdom (which is the increase in the number of guests for over 60%) will visit Montenegro in 2004, having, as estimated, over 25,000 overnights. Thus, tourism offer of Montenegro is slowly coming back to choosy and demanding British market.



ORGANISING COMMITTEE of inter-municipal enterprise for improving water supply of the coastal towns and Cetinje established

Organised by the Prime Minister Milo Djukanovic a meeting was held on 5th November on "Prerequisites for tourism season 2004 regarding water supply". Apart from the members of the Government, prospective donors and creditors, experts and members of the Secretariat of the Organising Committee were also present at the meeting.

On behalf of the Government of Montenegro, a member of the Organising Committee of inter-municipal enterprise for improving water supply in coastal towns and Cetinje is Mr Predrag Nenezic, Minister of Tourism. Coordinator of the project on behalf of the Government, Mr Branimir Gvozdenovic presented the concept consisting of internal measures relating to administrative, financial and organisational issues and urgent measures for improving water supply and measures for better use of existing sources as well as opening new sources of water supply with financial support of 13 million euros in total. The funds allocated to internal and urgent measures will amount to 7 million euros, while 3 million will be used for better utilisation of existing and 3 million for opening new local sources of water supply, is said in the announcement.

BRIEFING OF THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM COMMISSION

Ministry of Tourism's Commission for Categorisation and Classification of Hospitality Establishments gave a briefing on the results achieved so far at the Institute for Public Relations on 25 November.

So far 84 establishments were categorised in Montenegro, the Commission is considering 45 more applications, and there are less than 55 hotel owners and operators that did not apply for categorisation.

As the Commission announced today, 41 hotel complex, 30 small hotels 2 garni and 4 apart hotels as well as 3 pensions and 4 tourist villages were categorised. Five stars were awarded to Vila Montenegro at Sveti Stefan and hotels Sajo and Admiral Club from Budva. "These three hotels have 70 rooms altogether, which is common at the world market", explained the commission members at the briefing with journalists.

The advisor at the Ministry of Tourism, Fred Wieland pointed out that three hotels were awarded 4 stars. Three stars were awarded to 15 hotels and two tourist villages. Two stars were awarded to 21 hotels and two tourist villages. The lowest grade, one star was awarded to two hotels. Wieland explained that the aim of categorisation is to enhance conditions for guests from Western European market and to return Montenegrin tourism to the level it had 15 years ago with over 2.5 million foreign tourist overnights.

"It is also necessary to prolong the season which is only possible by having foreign tourists", said Wieland.

He is of the opinion that Montenegro, in order to meet the needs of foreign tourists, must reach international standards and have 5% of total facilities with 5 ***** , 35% with 4**** and 60% with 3***.

"Establishments with two and one star are mostly visited by domestic and tourists from former Yugoslavia", claims Wieland.

Categorisation was envisaged by Tourism Law, adopted last year, and the establishments are to meet minimum requirements for the given category. They include basic technical, fire safety and sanitary standards in accordance with national and local regulations and the relevant EU directives. Categories are determined based on exterior, environment, atmosphere, cleanliness, fittings, food and service quality, safety of guests, health and security procedures, recreational facilities, as well as professionalism, appearance and behaviour of personnel. Category certificate proposed by the Commission is issued by the Minister of Tourism and is valid for five years.

The Minister appoints tourism inspectors that constantly evaluate and monitor establishments, and regular inspections of each establishment are planned at least twice a year. The category may be degraded or suspended in case the establishment does not meet the prescribed standards, and such establishments will not be included in annual almanacs, catalogues and guides of National Tourism Organisation.

Applications for categorisation were submitted until 25 October, and official award is scheduled for Friday at Masa restaurant. The commission announced that categorisation of establishments at the North of Montenegro will start when they open.

ODISCUSSING PREREQUISITES FOR DEVELOPMENT OF ECO-TOURISM AT KOMOVI AND SKADAR LAKE

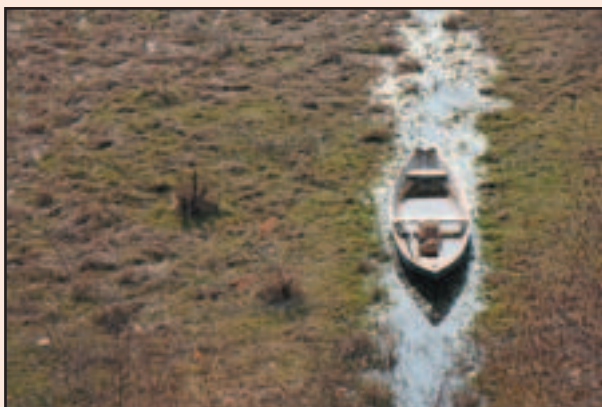
Podgorica, 11 November – As a part of the project of creating prerequisites for the development of ecotourism at Komovi and Skadar Lake, initiated by the NGO "Green Home", a round table was held at "Ribnica" restaurant on 11 November discussing the resources, opportunities and needs for the development of this type of tourism.

Participants were from non-governmental sector, civil servants from the national government and local self-governments of Podgorica, Bar and Andrijevica and they all stressed the need for cooperation of all sectors in defining a joint strategy in the development of this segment of tourism. One of the conclusions was the need to develop a strategy for development of ecotourism and creating legal framework.

The president of NGO "Green Home", Mr Darko Pajovic, speaking of the planned activities, pointed out that the basic aim of the project is to improve basis for the development of ecotourism at Komovi and Skadar Lake which have great natural prerequisites.

Luka Mitrovic, Deputy Minister for the Protection of Environment and Space Planning, spoke about natural value and resources of

this area for sustainable development of ecotourism. Komovi and Skadar Lake are very complex and geographically quite different



regions whose resources have been but little used for the development, emphasised Mitrovic. Speaking of distinctive features of Skadar Lake as a natural reserve of national importance, he pointed out that all aspects must be interconnected in nature-agriculture-tourism triangle. Speaking of rich resources and beautiful countryside of Komovi, Mitrovic also said that the zoning plan of Montenegro envisaged this mountain to be defined as a natural park.

Slobodan Lekovic, Deputy Minister of Tourism, spoke about great potentials for the development of ecotourism at Skadar Lake and its surroundings. He said that development priorities are recreational facilities and agriculture, provided that the environment is protected and cultural and historical monuments at the lake restored. In this area, Lekovic emphasises, 15 different aspects of tourism may be developed. He stressed particularly village, hunting and fishing, sport, event, excursion and other types of tourism. Prof. Dr Dragomir Kicovic, from environmental organisation "Komovi" from Andrijevica, agreed with this stressing that tourism resources of Komovi should be valued as well.

Category certificates and designation plates presented

Minister of Tourism, Predrag Nenezic presented certificates and designation plates to operators whose hospitality establishments were assessed on Friday 28 November at 12 o'clock at "Masa" restaurant in Podgorica.

So far 94 hospitality establishments have been categorised:

- 49 hotels (7562 rooms)
- 31 small hotels (642 rooms)
- 2 garni hotels (35 rooms)
- 5 apart hotels (107 rooms)
- 4 tourist settlements (2769 rooms)
- 3 pensions (123 rooms)

On the occasion, a brief presentation of the categorisation so far was given and a press cocktail held.

MINISTER OF TOURISM PREDRAG NENEZIC TALKED TO JOURNALISTS

Preparations for the winter and for the summer

Journalists of Montenegrin media covering tourism talked to Mr. Predrag Nenezic, the Minister of Tourism, on 18 November. During this informal meeting, that is to be held regularly in future, various topics relating to tourism were discussed. Preparations for winter tourism season are done as planned, and the program of "Hot Winter in the Hills" is being finalised. This year it is to take place, apart from Kolasin and Zabljak, also in Plav, Rozaje, and ski track



Vucje near Niksic, announced minister Nenezic.

Journalists were informed about considerable efforts to motivate the markets of Serbia and Vojvodina for the following season for which, apart from winter resorts, a number of coastal resorts is being prepared as well offering favourable packages, especially for weekends in wintertime. At the Government of Montenegro relevant ministries are making analysis and preparing a programme regarding the use of roadways to winter resorts and their cleaning and maintenance during winter. Until the winter season begins categorisation of hotels which submitted applications in due time will be completed.

The Minister and his associates informed the journalist of other activities undertaken by the Ministry, mostly relating to summer season. Tourism Satellite Accounting is to be started shortly. General slogan for the year 2004 will be National Cuisine of Montenegro which will result in about 200 restaurants having traditional Montenegrin dishes on their menus.

Credits for the development of small and medium-size businesses in tourism

At the beginning of December the Ministry of Tourism of Montenegro will announce a competition for credits to small and medium-size businesses in tourism, most probably amounting to 4 million. 1.8 million will be used to finance reconstruction projects for upgrading existing facilities, while 1.2 million will be for improving extra services. According to minister Nenezic, 600,000 will be used for SME at the north of Montenegro, and 400,000 for upgrading hotel facilities.

Maximum amount per applicant should be 50,000, plus additional support for any new employee.

The Ministry of Tourism is finalising negotiations with banks to participate in crediting.

Tourism signposting at the north

The North of Montenegro is to get tourism signposting by the beginning of next tourism season, announced Jelena Paovic, spokesperson of the Ministry of Tourism on December 19.

"Technical documentation is currently being prepared for the third stage of tourism signposting project in Montenegro and we expect works to begin in March next year", said Paovic. The project is financed by German

Association for Technical Cooperation. This organisation also financed the second stage of the project when tourism signs were placed along the roadway connecting Podgorica with the coast. Stage one included placing tourism signs along the main roads at the seaside, and these works were financed by European Agency for Reconstruction.

The Ministry of Tourism undertook to maintain and secure tourism signposts, and a tender has been invited for selecting a company that would at least twice a year do overall check of tourism signposts in Montenegro.

ORGANISED BY EMPLOYMENT OFFICE AND "GRONE" SCHOOL FROM LÜBECK, GERMANY

TRAINING FOR MONTENEGRIN CATERERS

After the first training session that lasted one month and was performed at the Institute "Dr Simo Milosevic", accompanied by intensive course of German language, 15 experienced caterers from Montenegro went to German town Lubeck where they are to spend another month on practical training in tourism and catering jobs. After their return from Lubeck, they are to attend classes for another month at the Institute. All those who pass the course successfully will be given certificates that enable them to be instructors not only in this country but anywhere within European Union.

It is a pilot project jointly realised and financed by the Employment Office of Montenegro and "Grone" school for adults from Lubeck training unemployed young people for 37 different jobs that are deficient at the market. The training is mostly practical and during the stay in Germany their Association of Tourism Employees will enable our candidates to present tourism offer of Montenegro to Neckerman, TUI and other agencies.
