VISIT OF GERMAN BUSINESS DELEGATION

GERMAN BUSINESS DELEGATION, HEADED BY MR DITMAR STAFFELT, PARLIAMENTARY UNDERSECRETARY OF STATE (SPD), FEDERAL MINISTRY OF ECONOMICS, VISITED MONTENEGRO FROM 22–25 MAY 2005.

DURING THEIR STAY IN MONTENEGRO, MR STAFFELT AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE GERMAN DELEGATION HAD TALKS WITH HIGH OFFICIALS OF THE GOVERNMENT AND THE PARLIAMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF MONTENEGRO, AS WELL AS MONTENEGRIN BUSINESSMEN AND EXPERTS. HEAD OF THE OFFICE OF GERMAN EMBASSY IN PODGORICA, MR BERNHARD ZOBEL AND HEAD OF THE ECONOMIC SECTION OF THE GERMAN EMBASSY IN BELGRADE, MR DIRK SCHULZ ALSO PARTICIPATED IN THE TALKS.

THE PURPOSE OF THEIR VISIT WAS TO REINFORCE BILATERAL RELATIONS AND CONSIDER POSSIBILITIES FOR ENHANCING BUSINESS COOPERATION BETWEEN MONTENEGRO AND FR GERMANY, WITH SPECIAL EMPHASIS ON TOURISM SECTOR. TO THAT END, ON 24TH MAY 2005, A PRESENTATION WAS ORGANISED AT SV. STEFAN, ENTITLED "TOURISM RESOURCES OF MONTENEGRO", AIMING TO INFORM GERMAN COUNTERPARTS ABOUT INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES INTO MONTENEGRIN TOURISM AND POSSIBILITIES OF ESTABLISHING CONCRETE COOPERA-

tion in implementing specific projects. Vice-president of the Government of Montenegro Branimir Gvozdenovic and Minister Nenezic accentuated the interest and openness of the Montenegrin side to intensify cooperation and informed the German delegation about the coming privatisations of large

business systems expressing their expectations that German investors will take an active part in these processes. Mr Staffelt and other members of the German delegation expressed their pleasure with significant advancements the Government of Montenegro had achieved on creating a more conducive environment for direct foreign investments, the fact particularly important for fostering accelerated sustainable development and development of Montenegro as an upscale market destination.



AFTER THE MEETING WITH THE BUSINESS DELEGATION OF GERMANY, MINISTER OF

TOURISM IN THE GOVERNMENT OF MONTENEGRO, MR PREDRAG NENEZIC, EXPRESSED HIS APPRECIATION OF EXCELLENT COOPERATION BETWEEN MONTENEGRO AND GERMANY AND THE HIGH LEVEL OF INTEREST FOR ENHANCING ECONOMIC RELATIONS OF THE TWO COUNTRIES, IMPLEMENTATION OF SPECIFIC PROJECTS AND THE INCREASE OF DIRECT GERMAN INVESTMENTS IN MONTENEGRO.

NGOS

The Ministry of Tourism has provided over 80,000 euros for NGO projects, through its programme of incentives for tourism development. At the competition for allocation of funds for NGO projects, announced by the Ministry of Tourism on 7 March 2005, 118 NGOs from Montenegro applied.



The Commission for cooperation with NGOs assessed all project proposals that arrived before the deadline, which was within 30 days after the announcement. Project proposals were ranked according to the following criteria: originality of the idea, time frame for project implementation, contribution of the project to enhancement of tourism product of Montenegro, amount of funds requested, number of people engaged in the project, etc. Upon the assessment of project proposals according to the given criteria, the Commission decided on the allocation of funds, eventually supporting 43 NGOs whose projects aim at promoting different types of tourism.

On the occasion the Commission of the Ministry of Tourism for the allocation of funds to NGOs had a press briefing at the National Press Centre in Podgorica on 10th May 2005.

MITF - MOSCOW

At the Moscow International Travel Fair (MITF), held from 12-15 May this year at the impressive exhibition centre "Gostiniy Dvor", with some 1,000 exhibitors, 40 of them foreign ones from almost every tourism destination in Europe, Montenegrin tourism offer was presented by a delegation headed by the Vice President of the Government of Montenegro, Mr Branimir Gvozdenovic. The presence of Montenegro at this significant tourism event was the result of an agreement made by the Prime Minister Dukanovic and the mayor of Moscow Yuriy Luzhkov on the occasion of presentation of Montenegrin tourism resources in Moscow in December last year.

In the presence of a large number of tourism professionals from all over Russia (from 80, out of 89 regions of the Russian Federation), the fair was officially opened by the Mayor of Moscow Yuriy M. Luzhkov.

This year MITF was organised by Moscow City Government, rather its Tourism Committee, and under the auspices of Mr Luzhkov. Apart from the Vice President of the Government, members of Montenegrin delegation participating at the opening of the fair were also Vojin Vlahovic, the advisor to the President of the Government and the director of the

National Tourism Organisation and Milan Rocen, the Ambassador of Serbia and Montenegro in Moscow.

Having officially opened the fair, Mr Luzhkov visited the showroom and the stand of the National Tourism Organisation of Montenegro and talked to the members of Montenegrin delegation and our tour-operators in Russia. Both sides agreed that, judging by the interest shown and the announcements, the increasing trend of arrivals from Russia to Montenegro is going to continue.

During the fair, on Friday 13 May, Vice-president of the Government Branimir Gvozdenovic and the director of NTO Vojin Vlahovic, had a press conference at the press centre of "Gostiniy Dvor" attended by numerous journalists from the Russian media.



In cooperation with the Ministry of Culture of the Russian Federation, the exhibition of Montenegrin artist Nikola Gvozdenovic was organised at the display area of the Directorate for Exhibitions and Auctions, with a cocktail party and music performance.

During their stay in Moscow Mr Branimir Gvozdenovic and Mr Vojin Vlahovic had a number of meetings with business people and officials of the Russian Federation, where they agreed to continue with successful cooperation between the Russian Federation and the Republic of Montenegro.

3rd BUDVA CARNIVAL

The 3rd International Carnival of Budva entitled "Towards the new Summer", organised by the NGO called Festaduni and under the auspices of the Ministry of Tourism, was held from 7-8 May this year. The carnival procession consisted of 35 carnival groups, 11 from abroad, 12 from Montenegro, and as many as 14 from the host town.

Before the beginning of the carnival fiestas, at Citadel, within the Old Town, the hosts organised an official reception for many invitees, representatives of carnival groups and journalists.

The carnival was "consecrated" by Mr Henry van der Kroon, President of the International Board of FECC (Foundation of European Carnival Cities) who granted the awards to the organisers

on the occasion. Welcoming the participants of this event marking the beginning of the main tourism season at the coast of Montenegro, the Minister of Tourism Predrag Nenezic expressed his appreciation of the good organisation and pleasure of having so many participants, underlining that this event contributes significantly to the promotion of tourism offer of Budva and Montenegro.

Carnival spirit was all-pervading these days in Budva; the streets were packed with both foreign visitors and masked guests from European carnival cities.

Budva carnival festivities proceeded with dancing and singing in front of the Mogren Hotel and on the streets and squares of the Old Town.

MALTA

The Government of Montenegro delegation, headed by the Vice-president Branimir Gvozdenovic and the Minister of Tourism Predrag Nenezic, visited Malta from 26–28 May for the 25th FECC Convention.



During the visit to Malta, Vice-president Gvozdenovic and Minister Nenezic had talks with the Dr Edward Fenech-Adami, the President of Malta and had many bilateral meetings with representatives of

other countries participating to the Convention, Mr Censu Galea, Minister for Communication and Competition, Dr. Francis Zammit Dimech, Minister of Tourism and Culture and the Mayor of Valetta, the capital of Malta. During the talks with the Minister for Communications and Competition both sides agreed that there are significant opportunities for cooperation and sharing experiences regarding maritime and air transport. Malta is ready, in this respect as well as regarding safeguarding competition, to share experiences with Montenegro and provide expertise in harmonisation with EU standards. The Minister of Tourism and Trade of Malta expressed great willingness to enhance cooperation with Montenegro and offered concrete forms of support and sharing experiences in this field.

During this year Convention of Carnival Towns of Europe, the Minister of Tourism Predrag Nenezic offered the candidature of Montenegro to be the host of the carnival towns of Europe convention in 2009. On the occasion, he was also inaugurated as FECC international senator.

Tourist signs in Budva

Within its project "Tourist signs in urban centres", the Ministry of Tourism initiated the activities on putting up tourist signs, boards and guideposts within the Municipality of Budva.

To that effect, upon the completion of tender procedure for selection of developer, the Ministry of Tourism signed a contract with the design office from Kotor called "Montecep". The Ministry has undertaken to finance the implementation of tourist signposting project for the municipality of Budva, and the developer to finish the works in 30 days and do it in accordance with European standards and recommendations of the World Tourism Organisation. Tourist signs, as a segment of overall tourist infrastructure marking tourist attractions and sites of general interest, should provide for better information and make it easier for visitors to find their way around and thus enhance the quality of offer of this largest tourist municipality. Apart from the municipality of Budva, three more municipalities will be included in the "Tourism signposting in urban areas" project (Bar, Tivat, Herceg Novi). Within stage two of the project two more municipalities will be covered, Kotor and Ulcinj, and some mountain resorts in Montenegro.

By the beginning of summer season, tourist signs will also have been set in Tivat and Bar, while for the municipality of Herceg Novi the project has been designed and the municipality will invite tenders.

Ministry of Tourism announced the tender for maintenance of existing signs that during the phase one of the project were set along all the major roadways in Montenegro.

We expect that this year a company shall be chosen to be put in charge of tourist signs maintenance.



Within preparations for the summer tourism season 2005, the Ministry of Tourism of Montenegro launched a campaign entitled "Let It Be Clean", carried out as public works within the national employment programme.

These works include removal of waste, cleaning and maintenance of the area along major roads in Montenegro of total length of 550 kilometres.

This project covers the roadways from Debeli brijeg to Ada Bojana, from Budva to Cetinje, and the municipalities of Podgorica, Kolasin, Niksic, Zabljak, Bijelo Polje and Rozaje, as well as many more roads in Montenegro. The programme is implemented as public works, thus has the double impact: providing work for the unemployed, increasing their work capacity and addressing the problem of uncleanness along the roadways at the coastal and northern region of Montenegro.

During the first stage, lasting for two months, most of the work will be done engaging 140 unemployed persons, while stage two is to last three months and would involve maintaining cleanness of the areas along the roadways engaging 70 more workers. By launching "Let It Be Clean" campaign we wish to show both to ourselves and our visitors that we are ready to work seriously on environmental protection and affirmation of this destination as an ecological state.

The implementation of this project started in early April and is to last until late August.

PRESENTATION OF MONTENEGRIN TOURISM IN KIEV

During this year Eurosong in Kiev, 19th May, at one of the main Ukrainian information agencies, Predrag Nenezic, Montenegrin Minister of Tourism, held a press conference thus launching "Days of Montenegro in Kiev".

The boys from "No Name" and the ambassador of Serbia and Montenegro in Kiev, Goran Aleksic were also present at the press conference.

The interest expressed for this conference and the interest of journalists and travel agencies confirm that Montenegro is an attractive tourist destination for Ukrainians. The purpose of Montenegro delegation visiting Kiev was to establish connections with tourism industry of Kiev, National Tourism Organisation of Ukraine and establish contacts that may result in the increase of the number of arrivals from this market.

As part of promotional activities, on 19th May the Ministry of Tourism organised a reception for distinguished persons from political, social and cultural life and members of the media and tourism industry in Ukraine.

Since representatives of 39 European countries were visiting Kiev at the time, Minister Nenezic talked with many of them promoting our tourism offer. Ukraine is a large market where this was one of our first serious presentations and after which we have good announcements for this season.

Travel agencies from Montenegro have already agreed with Ukrainians to have two charter flights a week, and there is also a possibility of introducing an extra flight during the high season.

We believe that our visit to Kiev, especially the participation of our representatives at the finals of Eurosong, having achieved good ranking, contributed to greater popularity of Montenegro as a tourism destination not only in Ukraine but also in other parts of the world.

NEW CAMPAIGN OF THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM FOR REGISTRATION OF PRIVATE ACCOMMODATION

With the new amendments to the Tourism Law, the Ministry of Tourism further elaborated on a number of provisions introducing incentives for natural persons to legalize the rental of accommodation they offer in their private establishments. It is a new project by which we endeavour to motivate all those renting accommodation to tourists to do it in a legalized way. With different incentives and a much simpler procedure, harmonised with the Ministry of Finance, Tax Administration and all the municipalities we try to register as many beds as possible rented in private houses and introduce them into the system in order to monitor quality and set standards in this field.

Providing accommodation to tourists is covered by the Regulation on lump sum taxing of revenues from independent activities. Following the simplified procedure, approval for operation may be obtained by submitting the title deed and certificate of occupancy or electrical certificate of compliance. At the request of the owners of privately rented accommodation, competent municipal body shall within 15 days issue the approval for operation and categorise the accommodation facilities.

Monthly amount of dues is between 80 and 90 euros, amounting to less than 300 euros for full three months. All private renters that register this year will be included in the catalogue of private accommodation as well as be presented at domestic and foreign fairs. In cooperation with the municipalities, the Ministry of Tourism has launched the "Register your Establishment" campaign. In order to promote the campaign, a number of jingles and promotional video spots are broadcasted via all local and other radio and TV stations inviting all rentals of private accommodation to register their establishment. In order to provide detailed information and familiarise the interested party with the registration procedure a number of round table discussions was organised.

COORDINATION BODY FOR THE PREPARATION OF SUMMER TOURIST SEASON

In order to have quality preparations for the summer tourism season, Coordination Body for its preparation is active in undertaking all the activities for the season to be prepared well.

According to the Action Plan for the preparation of this year tourist season and conclusions from Coordination Body meetings, great achievements have been made in preparations for the coming season. Hotels are ready for the beginning of the season, with a new offer of a number of modern small hotels and pensions.

New border crossing at Debeli Brijeg and Sozina tunnel will have started operating by the beginning of high season, while water

and energy supply will be stable. Significant investments have been made into technical equipment and operation of the Coast Guard to provide for safety of swimmers and environmental protection of the sea.

The Ministry of Interior has greatly simplified the administrative procedure at border crossings and minimised the number of checks. Traffic police had trainings of wardens regarding foreign language proficiency, while, in order to be better equipped to contribute to better control, the Ministry of Tourism provided ten new motorcycles for traffic wardens.

Implementation of projects defined by the



Action Plan is done according to set timeframes and we expect to have yet another successful season ahead of us.
